- Yellow Fever vaccination MANDATORY (5275)
- Malaria medication is not mandatory, but it is suggested that the medication be purchased (approximately S69) Talk with your personal physician for further instructions.
- Make sure your prescription medication is in its original packaging.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

 Current Passport. There should be at least 4 blank pages in your passport book. Senegal does not require a visa for U.S. Passport holders
